

Derbyshire Archaeology Badge Behaviours

Out and about

- Keep to footpaths and respect the Countryside Code
 - Close gates, don't disturb farm animals or nesting birds, or damage plants
- Do not trespass, get permission before going on to privately owned land
- Leave no trace of your visit and take all your litter home
- · Safely dispose of any rubbish you find
- Treat the site you are visiting with care and respect
- Pay attention to instructions from your guide and to signage
- Report any historical finds to an adult or the landowner

Excavations

- Do not enter the excavation area without permission
- Treat the excavation area with care and respect
- Stand well away from the edge of trenches (for your own safety and to avoid damaging the trench)
- Show any finds to your guide; take nothing away from the site without permission
- Only take photographs with permission

Thinking of others

- Respect others and their opinion
- Respect the people of the past, from their activities to their beliefs

Remember that when you are out and about you are an ambassador for Scouts.

Do nothing that might give Scouting a bad name.
